Assumptions

- Local governments are interested in engaging in innovation at a regional scale
- Local governments are willing to share resources, and allocate time to the program
- Local governments understand their pain points and local areas of concern
- Local governments are capable of working together and reaching consensus

Risks

- Local governments don't have capacity / human resources to engage in the program
- Local governments don't have financial resources to contribute to the program
- Covid-19 or other external factor impacts on the ability to gather / host events
- Significant expertise is not available to manage the program
